Articles submitted to the journal should meet these criteria and must not be under consideration for publication elsewhere. Manuscripts should follow the style of the journal and are subject to both review and editing.
- ◆ For those who're NOT looking to publish their papers, it's acceptable to submit your abstracts to the conference just for oral presentation without publication, which will be sent to at least two technical committees for a brief review, and it will take about 10 working days.
